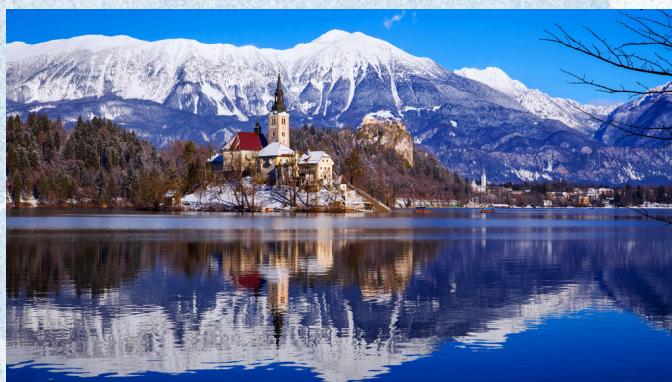

- If any coach is not fully booked, extra lessons can be booked and paid for at the welcome meeting.



Frequently Asked Questions

How do I book and when do I need to pay?

First, please review the terms and conditions below. Then, [click here to register](#) and see the payment details.

- Normal Fee: €350 per person, book by 1st December 2025.

Your place will be confirmed when full payment is received. Places are limited so book early to avoid disappointment.

What if I do not want to attend the full camp?

We are currently offering only the full 3-day camp. However, if places are still available after 1st December 2026, we will introduce a day rate option and we will notify you if day-rate places become available.

Where is the nearest airport?

Lake Bled 45 mins from Ljubljana. There is a cheap shuttle bus to and from the airport costing approx £18 each way or private taxi is approx.£51.The main station operates a frequent service to Lesce-Bled and Bled Jezero, which is approximately 40 minutes by train. Where can I stay near to the ice rink?

Lake Bled International Winter Ice Dance Week 2026 Terms & Conditions

These terms and conditions apply to all participants attending the Lake Bled International Winter Ice Dance Camp 2026. By signing up for the camp, you agree to abide by the following conditions:

1.Registration and Payments

1.1 Booking and Payments

All participants must complete the registration form and make full payment before their place will be confirmed. An Early Bird rate is available as follows:

- **Normal price: 3-day camp = €350 per person for payments by 1st December 2025**

1.2 Cancellation by Organiser

The organisers reserve the right to cancel the camp at any time if necessary. In the event that the camp cannot proceed due to insufficient bookings, payments will be refunded in full.

2.Changes to Coaches or Schedule

2.1 Coach Availability

The organisers reserve the right to change the scheduled coaches if a coach is unable to attend due to unforeseen circumstances. In such cases, standby or substitute coaches will be arranged to ensure the continuity of the camp.

2.2 Session Adjustments

The camp organisers may alter the camp schedule if necessary. In the case of any significant schedule adjustments, participants will be informed as soon as possible.

2.3 Private Lessons

We must receive 24 hours notice if you wish to change your private lesson booking. Full payment will be charged for cancellations with less than 24 hours notice.

3.Participant Health and Safety

3.1 Medical Fitness

All participants must be in good physical health and must provide a medical clearance if requested by the organisers. Participants are required to notify the organisers of any pre-existing medical conditions or injuries that could affect their ability to participate in the camp.

3.2 Injuries and Accidents

First aid provision will be available on-site during all scheduled sessions. Any injuries that occur during camp activities must be immediately reported to the first aid representative (coaches). The organisers are not responsible for any injuries sustained during organised camp sessions.

3.3 Insurance

Participants are strongly advised to hold personal accident and travel insurance to cover injuries, cancellations, and other unforeseen circumstances. The camp organisers are not liable for any medical costs, lost personal items, or travel disruptions.

3.4 Safety Guidelines

Safety notices will be displayed and relayed to participants before the start of the camp. By signing the terms and conditions, you agree to abide by these guidelines, which are designed to ensure the safety of all participants

4. Force Majeure and External Circumstances

4.1 Force Majeure Clause

The camp organisers will not be held responsible for any cancellation or disruption caused by events outside of their control, including but not limited to war, natural disasters, pandemics, extreme weather, government-imposed travel restrictions or last-minute ice rink closure. In such events, refunds will be subject to the organisers receiving a refund from the venue and service providers. The organisers reserve the right to deduct any non-recoverable costs incurred up to the date of cancellation.

4.2 Travel Disruptions

Participants are responsible for ensuring that they have valid travel documentation. The organisers are not liable for any missed sessions or refunds due to travel disruptions such as flight delays, visa issues, or lost baggage. Travel insurance is strongly recommended.

5. Venue and Equipment

5.1 Venue Changes or Failures

In the event that the venue is unable to host the camp due to equipment failures, structural issues, or other unforeseen circumstances, the organisers will attempt to relocate to an alternative venue. If a suitable alternative cannot be found, participants will be refunded in accordance with section 4.1.

5.2 Participant Responsibility for Equipment

Participants are responsible for their own skating equipment and belongings. The organisers are not liable for lost, damaged, or stolen personal property during the camp.

6. Behaviour and Code of Conduct

6.1 Code of Conduct

All participants are expected to behave respectfully towards other skaters, coaches, and staff. Discriminatory, abusive, or bullying behaviour will not be tolerated. Participants who breach this code of conduct may be expelled from the camp without refund.

6.2 Conflict Resolution

Any disputes or conflicts during the camp should be brought to the attention of the organisers. All attempts will be made to resolve disputes amicably, but the organisers reserve the right to remove participants who are disruptive to the event.

7. Dietary and Allergy Considerations

7.1 Personal Responsibility

Participants are required to provide information regarding any allergies or dietary requirements at the time of registration. Participants with severe allergies must bring any necessary medications (e.g., EpiPens) and inform the organisers of their condition. The organisers are not liable for allergic reactions caused by food or other environmental factors during the camp.

8. Photography and Media

8.1 Media Consent

By participating in the camp, participants consent to the use of photos and videos taken during the camp for promotional and marketing purposes. If you do not wish to be included in any media, please notify the organisers in advance.

9. Refund Policy

9.1 Participant-Initiated Cancellations

Refunds for participant-initiated cancellations will only be issued in exceptional circumstances or if another skater is willing to take your place. An administration fee may be deducted.

9.2 Force Majeure Refunds

If the camp is cancelled due to force majeure (as outlined in section 4.1), refunds will only be processed if the organisers receive a refund from the venue and service providers. Non-recoverable expenses may be deducted.

10. Liability

10.1 Waiver of Liability

By signing up for the Lake Bled International Winter Ice Dance Camp 2026, participants acknowledge that ice skating is an inherently risky activity and accept full responsibility for any personal injury or damage to property incurred during the camp. The organisers, coaches, and venue management are not liable for any accidents, injuries, or losses sustained during the event.

Agreement

By registering for the Lake Bled International Winter Ice Dance Camp 2026, participants (and their legal guardians, if applicable) agree to abide by these terms and conditions. Failure to comply with any part of this agreement may result in removal from the camp without refund. By submitting a registration form, you consent to the storage of your personal data and agree to receive communications, including newsletters and updates about our programs and events. You can unsubscribe at any time.
